Greetings Shir Tikvah,

As we shared with you last week, we have invited Rabbi Arielle Rosenberg and her fiancé Noam Lekach to join us for Shabbat on March 31/April 1. There will be several opportunities for the Congregation to meet Rabbi Rosenberg and Noam, sing with her and study Torah with her. We're excited to share with you what her schedule will be while she is in town.

Please plan to join us for one or all of the following:

- **Friday night Shabbat service, March 31 at 6:30pm**- Rabbi Rosenberg will help lead Services and she will deliver the D'var Torah.
- **Saturday morning, April 1 at 9:30am** - Rabbi Rosenberg will tell a story during Tot Shabbat.
- **Saturday afternoon, April 1 at 3-4:30 pm** - Rabbi Rosenberg will lead a "Rebbe's Tisch" in the Shir Tikvah sanctuary. "Rebbe's Tisch" is yiddish for Rabbi's Table. We will sing, nosh, and be with Rabbi Rosenberg for a learning and singing session that will include her favorite Torah on singing as a spiritual practice and she will share with us some of the melodies that make her heart soar. The Tisch is meant to be participatory -- so bring your voices!

The Hiring Advisory Team will be asking for your thoughts and feedback about Rabbi Rosenberg. Before she arrives, we will send out a series of questions for your consideration during the weekend. On Sunday the HAT will formally interview her and because of our compressed time frame, we will need your feedback by **Sunday, April 2 at 12pm**. Of course, we will keep you updated along the way.
