CLERGY-MUSIC POSITION

Shir Tikvah Congregation Spring 2017

Participatory, soulful music is central to the worship and identity of Shir Tikvah. This Clergy person reports to the Senior Rabbi and is a member of the Clergy Team, along with the Associate Rabbi/Director of Lifelong Learning. Primary Responsibilities Include:

DAVENNING/PRAYER/BUILDING A SINGING COMMUNITY:

- Lead music for worship and life cycle events, including leading and supervising instrumental ensemble, choir, and lay prayer leaders
- Train, support, and supervise lay musicians and davenning team leaders
- Coordinate the Ritual Calendar
- Oversee Thursday morning Minyan
- Provide and Coordinate davenning for High Holy Days, Simchat Torah, Shabbat Shira, and Purim
- Inspire our youngest generation through participatory musical & prayer experiences. Set vision for, create and oversee Hebrew & Religious School T'filah, Tot Shabbat, and Children's Choir activities

SPIRITUAL ENGAGEMENT:

- Engage every generation, from youngest to oldest, new and veteran alike, in the spiritual and ritual life of Shir Tikvah
- Provide pastoral counseling and guidance as needed to congregants
- Partner with members to create Jewish rituals to mark life transitions

B'NEI MITZVAH

- Oversee innovative B'nei Mitzvah program, which includes:
 - Coordinate 6th Grade Shabbat morning monthly program
 - Hire and supervise B'nei Mitzvah tutors
 - Supervise teaching of Trope in 6th Grade and to Adult B'nei Mitzvah cohort
