

Shir Tikvah Day of Service 2016 overview

Over 150 individual volunteers were involved in accomplishing all of the items below.

What was provided:

- Prepared meals for 280* at Youthlink, Our Savior's Emergency Housing, Simpson House
**Does not include the meals for the Families Moving Forward families over the 2 week period*
- Made 500 sandwiches for The Sandwich Project, Simpson House and Our Savior's Emergency Housing
- Assembled approximately 50 homeless care kits (with socks, water bottle, handwarmers, snack)
- Served breakfast and dinner to over 800 (food provided by shelters)
- Packaged 200 single serve bags of laundry detergent, 20 tutoring bags and 100 snack packs – People Serving People
- Over 110 pairs of socks and underwear, along with a hefty supply of soap, deodorant, toothpaste, shampoo and conditioner - Simpson House
- Over 150 pairs of children's socks/underwear and 60 diapers - Families Together

Special thanks to the Religious School families for providing all of the supplies they were tasked with donating. Truly amazing!

We are still collecting gently used jeans (through February 15) to be donated to teen homeless shelters through the Teens for Jeans program. Read more here:
