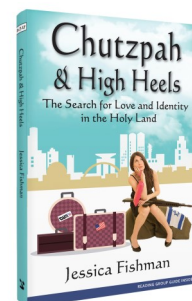

Guest Speaker, Jessica Fishman Friday, March 17 at 6:30pm Services

Having grown up in the Twin Cities in a Jewish and Zionist family, Jessica Fishman moved to Israel after graduating from Indiana University with a degree in Journalism and Business. She spent her first few years in the country serving in the Israel Defense Forces, learning the Hebrew language, and getting acclimated to the country. After developing the popular Aliyah Survival Blog, which is an irreverent portrayal of an American immigrant's first years in Israel, she has written a deeply personal, witty memoir about the difficulties, absurdities, and excitement of making a home in a new country.

She was inspired to write *Chutzpah and High Heels: The Search for Love and Identity in the Holy Land* after a life-changing event in Israel. Her goals are to share her experience and inspire social change.
